This maintenance product treats and revives previously treated or coated wood surfaces, where waxes, oils, varnishes, or sealers have been used.

### USES

#### INTERIOR

For use on all previously treated or coated interior wood furniture and woodwork, where waxes, oils, varnishes, or sealers have been used, as a wipe-on maintenance and cleaning wax. Use on tables, chairs, wood panelling, wardrobes, walls, and other furniture pieces.

### DO NOT PAINT IF

IF THE TEMPERATURE IS BELOW 10°C OR ABOVE 35°C  
IF THE SURFACE IS DAMP (MOISTURE READING ABOVE 15%)  
IF IT IS RAINING OR RAIN IS FORECAST  
BEFORE 9H00 AND AFTER 16H00 IN THE WINTER

### IMPORTANT

Fired Earth Furniture Liquid Oil will not act as a sealer coating finish, it is a liquid maintenance and cleaning wax, keeping wood in pristine condition. Ensure that the wood is completely dry before treating it with Fired Earth Furniture Liquid Wax. In cold weather, a white solidified wax could appear. Warm container in a bowl of hot water until the white wax is fluid and shake thoroughly. Do not warm over an exposed flame or direct heat. Wax precipitates at temperatures below 100C. Note: not recommended to use on wooden floors because of waxy finish it became slippery.

### PREVIOUSLY TREATED

Previously treated or coated interior wood furniture and woodwork, where waxes, oils, varnishes, or sealers have been used: Thoroughly clean and prepare the wood surfaces by removing all dust, dirt, grease, grime, and loose contaminants before starting to paint.

### SURFACE PREPARATION & APPLICATION

Wipe down using Mineral Turpentine and mutton cloth, to remove dirt and grime. Multiple wipes may be required. Apply a minimum of 1-2 coats of Fired Earth Furniture Liquid Wax and up to 3 coats if extremely porous. Apply sparingly to less porous wood surfaces to avoid excess residue of product.

Previously treated or coated interior wood furniture and woodwork, where waxes, oils, varnishes, or sealers surfaces fair condition: Wipe down using Mineral Turpentine and mutton cloth, to remove dirt and grime. Multiple wipes may be required. Mechanically clean using steel wool, abrading the surface in the direction of the wood grain. Wipe down using Lacquer Thinners and mutton cloth, to remove dust and residue. Apply a minimum of 1-2 coats of Fired Earth Furniture Liquid Wax and up to 3 coats if extremely porous. Apply sparingly to less porous wood surfaces to avoid excess residue of product.

Previously treated or coated interior wood furniture and woodwork, where waxes, oils, varnishes, or sealers surfaces which are cracked, discolored, weathered, or flaking:

Strip back to bare wood, either by sanding or with a Fired Earth Paint Stripper. Rinse thoroughly with water and allow to dry. Sand to smooth finish using a 150-grit sanding paper or finer grades to produce the desired smooth surface. Remove dust, allow to dry, and treat as for new wood, before applying the selected Fired Earth wood care product.

### HEALTH & SAFETY

The product contains a flammable solvent. Precaution must be taken to prevent naked flames encountering vapours (i.e. smoking must be prohibited). Solvents may also cause narcotic effects if the vapour concentration is too high: always ensure adequate ventilation (do not use solvent-based paints in a poorly ventilated or closed space). Avoid contact with skin, eyes, mouth etc. Wear protective clothing, goggles & gloves. If body contact is made, rinse off immediately. Wash product off skin before it has dried using soap and water.
