SURFACE PREPARATION

New Work:

Cement plaster, one coat Plaster primer and one coat of Universal Undercoat.

Metal, if rusted remove all rust, two coats Anti-corrosive metal primer and apply one coat Universal Undercoat.

Wood, one coat Pink wood primer.

Previously painted surfaces:

Thoroughly clean surface by removing all dirt, grease, oil, algae, fungi, grime and flaking paint. Remove surface irregularity & bits using sanding paper grit P100/P200. Spot prime bare plaster, wood or metal with appropriate quality primer. Then apply 1 coat of Universal Undercoat followed by Gloss Enamel paint by choice of application as detailed in the application section.

HEALTH & SAFETY ADVICE

The product contains a flammable solvent. Precaution must be taken to prevent naked flames coming in contact with vapours (i.e. smoking must be prohibited). Solvents may also cause narcotic effects if the vapour concentration is too high: always ensure adequate ventilation (do not use solvent based paints in a poorly ventilated or closed space).
